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The Physician Assistant Committee of the Department of Consumer Affairs is adopting a new section requiring all licensees to disclose, prior to renewal of a license, whether he or she has been convicted of "any violation of the law in this or any other state, the United States, or other country, omitting traffic infractions under \$300 not involving alcohol, dangerous drugs, or controlled substances." Licensees must also disclose whether they have been denied a license, or been disciplined by another licensing authority, any where. Failure to comply renders the application for renewal incomplete and the "license will not be renewed until the licensee demonstrates compliance. . ."

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 11/4/2009.
